

Coast Dental Services, Inc. Company History

1992

The Company was initially incorporated in Florida as Sunshine Health Services, Inc. The company opened its first dental center.

1994

Sunshine Health Services, Inc. changed its name to Coast Dental, Inc.

1996

Coast Dental, Inc. was merged into Coast Dental Services, Inc., ("Coast Dental") a Delaware Corporation, for the purpose of reincorporating in the State of Delaware and changing the corporate name.

1997

The Company successfully completed an initial public offering in early 1997 and a secondary offering later that same year. The proceeds from these two offerings (roughly \$57 million) funded the vast majority of Coast Dental's rapid growth from 1 dental center in 1992 to over 100 in 1998.

2001

On July 17, Coast Dental moved the listing of its common stock from NASDAQ's National Market and began trading on NASDAQ's Small Cap Market.

2002

The Company changed its state of incorporation from Delaware to Florida pursuant to a reincorporation proposal approved by the shareholders at the annual meeting held on August 2, 2002.

2004

The Coast Dental Board of Directors determined that it was in the best interest of the shareholders and the company to terminate Coast Dental's status as a public company. Accordingly, the company deregistered from the SEC on April 7, 2004 and its stock moved from the NASDAQ Small Cap Market to the over-the-counter market the same day.

2005

Coast Dental's senior management team formed Intelident Solutions to effect a going-private transaction and position the company for future growth. Intelident Solutions is a privately-held company that now owns several dentistry-related business enterprises.

2006

Coast opens 16 new offices including its first entry in the South Florida market.

Intelident inks a multi-million deal with Kodak to phase in advanced digital imaging to Coast Dental offices. The agreement represents the first large-scale deployment of Kodak's RVG 6000 digital radiography system in the U.S.
